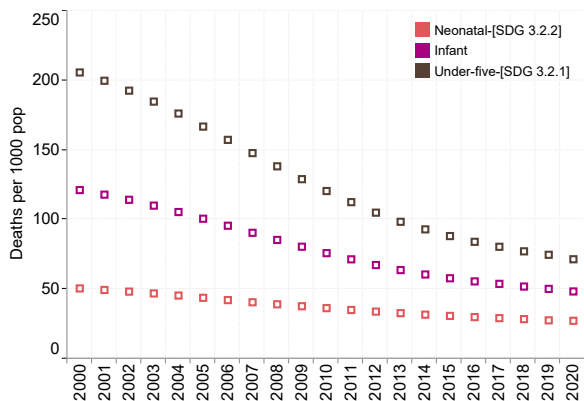

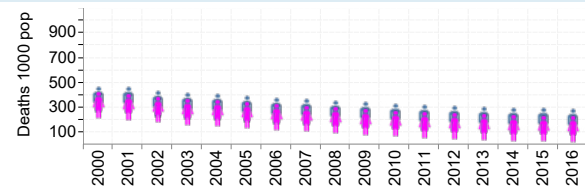

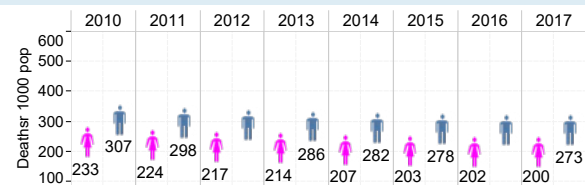
#### Under-five, Infant and neonatal mortality rates



#### Adolescent mortality rate

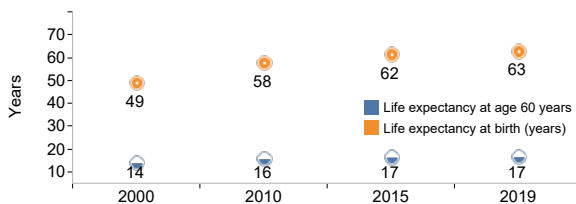


#### Adult mortality rate



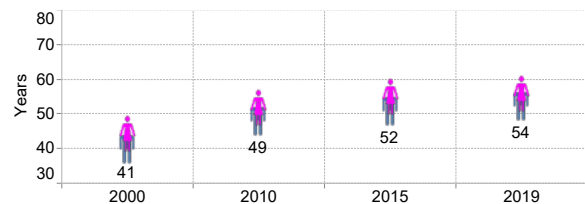
### Life expectancy (LE)

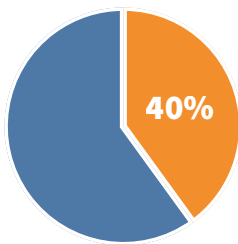

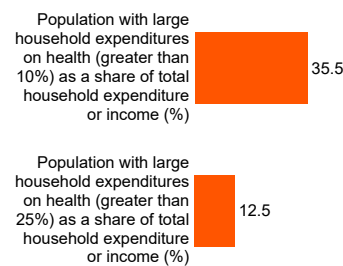

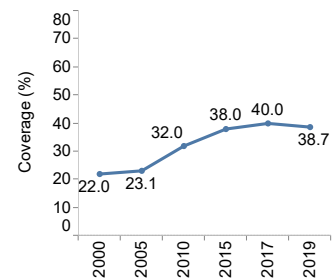
