

Age based mortality (Data source: WHO 2022)


Under-five, Infant and neonatal mortality rates








Life expectancy (LE) (Data source: WHO 2022)



International Health Regulations (IHR) core capacities index – [SDG 3.d.1] Source: WHO/AFRO 2022




