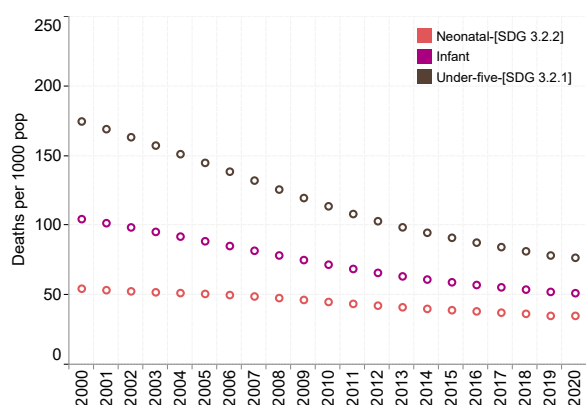

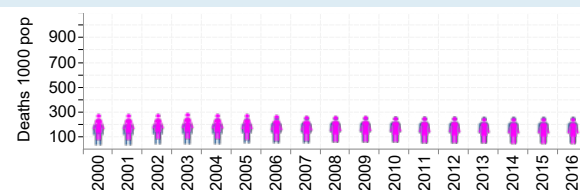

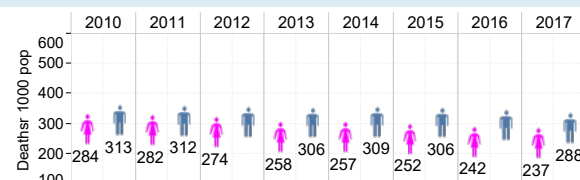
Under-five, Infant and neonatal mortality rates



Adolescent mortality rate

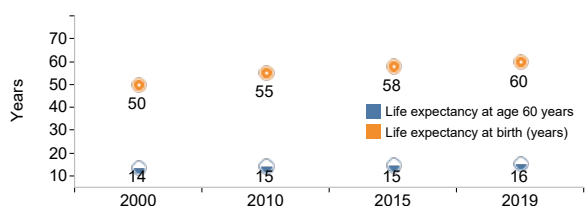


Adult mortality rate

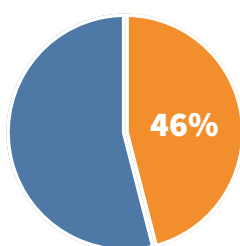

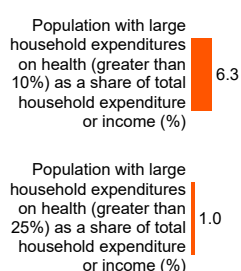

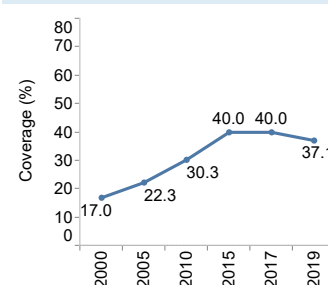
